with Physical Disabilities**

**TALLAHASSEE, FL** - The Tallahassee-Leon Shelter, Inc., serving the area homeless since 1988, and located at 480 West Tennessee Street, is pleased to announce that it has completed the addition of an ADA-compliant bathroom for the daytime use of its guests. It is located on the West side of the main building, at the rear of the driveway, and is fully equipped to serve our handicapped citizens who are homeless.

The Shelter has been open continuously since late 1991, 7 nights a week, 52 weeks a year.
